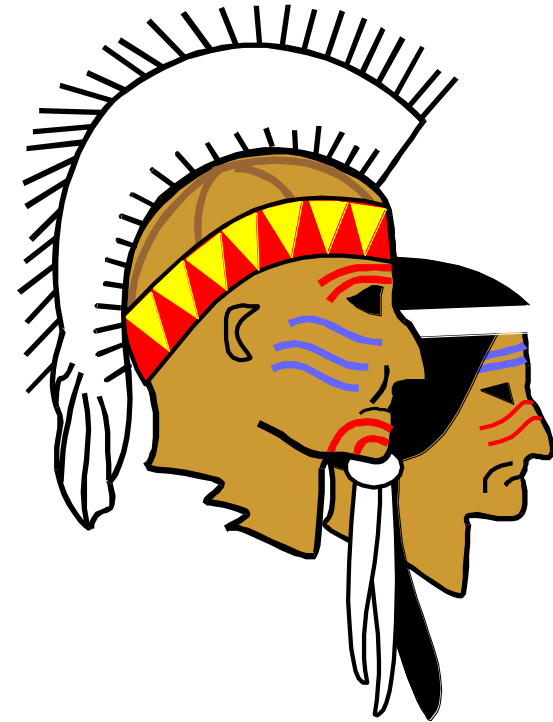

The Story of the Del-Mi District Patch

PREFACE

The Miami Indians ruled an area roughly extending eastward to Detroit and Cincinnati, and to the Great Lakes and the junction of the Wabash and Ohio Rivers westward.

The Delaware Indians lived in an area that is now the state of Delaware; and their name was derived from an early Governor of that colony, Lord De La Warr.

The advancing white settlers forced the Delawares west, and in the early 1800's, the Miamis agreed to let the Delawares have all the land watered by the White River.

SEPTEMBER 1972

After much discussion, the Big Caribou and Prairie Valley Districts decided to merge. The name selected for the new district is a contraction of the Delaware and Miami Indian tribes.

DEL-MI

The district patch, designed by Irv Brengle, tells the Del-Mi story in authentic Miami pictographs around the outer border. The heads represent a Miami Indian wearing a roach of long porcupine guard hairs and a Delaware Indian with braided hair. A fluff is at the base of the feather. Beginning at left center above the square and following the pictographs to the square on the right, the story is as follows:



"Many Scouters – from Big Caribou – and Prairie Valley – talked – morning, noon and night – and decided to become of one tribe."

Following from below the left square around the bottom of the patch, the story continues:



"This new tribe – will have many campouts – many campfires – and will walk many trails – during the Snow Moon – the Grass Moon – the Hunt Moon – and the Falling Leaf Moon."

Training Awards are national awards given for completion of training, performance and tenure requirements. "Training Cards" for each award are submitted by the Scouter, and are approved at the unit, district and council levels. Knots are available for these awards.

The ***Veteran Award*** is a national award for tenure. It is given in five-year increments, must be requested by the Scouter, and tenure must be complete for the award requested. (Pin)

The ***District Patch Award*** is an award given by the district (not a national award) in response to nomination by the unit. It is available for those Scouters with two years tenure who have shown outstanding service.

The ***Outstanding Service Award*** is an award given by the district (not a national award) in response to nomination by the unit. It is available for those Scouters who have shown outstanding service for five years.

The ***Continuing Service Award*** is given by the district (not a national award) for at least five years additional service in Del-Mi after receiving the Outstanding Service Award. It also requires nomination by the unit.

The ***New-Unit Organizer Award*** is a national recognition available to a Scouter who has greatly assisted in the formation of a new unit. (Knot available)

The ***Unit Leader Award of Merit*** is a national recognition (formerly, the Scoutmaster or Venturing Leader Award of Merit) of a Scouter with at least 18 months tenure as a Unit Leader and who has met other program and training requirements. (Knot available).

The ***District Award of Merit*** is a national award given by the district to a Scouter who has displayed outstanding service to youth at a district level. Del-Mi, according to size by units, may give four awards. (Knot available)

The ***Silver Beaver Award*** is a national award given by the council to a Scouter who has displayed outstanding service to youth. It is the highest award that can be given by the council. (Knot available)
